LIVING ROOFS

- P.1 Glass, steel and concrete these are the materials that cities are made of. As cities grow, the few green areas left are often replaced by even more buildings. But all that is changing. More and more cities around the world are turning to "green roofs" to bring nature back to cities.
- P.2 A green roof is a roof of a building that is partly or completely covered with plants. Soil is placed on top of a special waterproof material to prevent the water that is used for irrigation from leaking into the building. Then grass, flowers and even trees are planted, changing a bare roof into a green one.
- P.3 Green roofs serve various purposes. By constructing and developing green roofs on city office buildings, companies provide their workers with a safe, pleasant place to spend their breaks. Apartment dwellers can go up to the roof in order to enjoy a garden. Jack Hills, a Manhattan resident, says, "My green roof helps me unwind at the end of a long day. It's a welcome change from the New York City stress and noise".
- P.4 While green roofs are a welcome and relaxing addition to busy city life, they have other advantages as well. For example, green roofs are insulators which protect the buildings they grow on from both heat and cold. In this way, much less energy is needed to cool the buildings in the summer or to heat them in the winter. In some cases, more than 50% less energy is needed.
- Researchers have been amazed at some of the effects green roofs have on their surroundings. They have found that a concentration of green roofs on city buildings can help lower the average temperatures of the city during the hot summer months.
- P.6 Finally, green roofs serve as natural habitats for birds and other small animals giving them places where they can live and making it possible for them to survive city life.
- P.7 As more and more green roofs are built, cities are becoming more pleasant places to live and work.
